


#### 1. Eraser

Use the end of the stylus to erase handwritten notes.


#### 2. Customizable Button

For erasing: Hold the side button when the tip is over 1cm away, then tap the screen.





For custom functions: Keep the tip within 1cm of the screen while holding the side button, then tap the screen.






#### Quick Access Control Panel

## Multitasking


Swipe up from the bottom of the screen to open the multitasking interface. Quickly switch between apps or close background apps.



#### How to Add Custom Note Templates

- ①Import template images (PNG, JPG, etc.) into the [template] folder via USB.
- 20pen the template menu at the top and select Custom.
- Tap the imported template to add it.

#### Audio-to-Text / Translation




#### Smart Pen Overview

#### How to Use the Smart Pen


Step 1: Press the side button during writing to quickly activate Smart Pen mode.



Step 2: Circle handwritten content to move it, perform AI search, and more.



Step 3: Press the side button and draw shapes like O  $\,\pm\,\Delta$  in front of handwritten content. The system will automatically convert them into standard shapes and add the associated content to To-Do, Follow-Up, or Subheading categories.



#### Calendar Overview

Link third-party calendar accounts for two-way sync of calendar events and to-do items



Calendar View all calendar events, tasks, and notes for the day, with options to switch between different calendar views.

## How to Import Books and Documents

- ① Connect AINOTE to your PC via USB.
- $\textcircled{2} \ \mathsf{Copy} \ \mathsf{eBooks} \ (\mathsf{PDF}, \mathsf{EPUB}, \mathsf{MOBI}, \mathsf{TXT}, \mathsf{AZW}) \ \mathsf{to} \ \mathsf{the} \ [\mathsf{Bookshelf}] \ \mathsf{folder}.$
- $\label{eq:copy} \textbf{Office documents (DOC(X), PPT(X), XLS(X)) to the [Office] folder.}$
- ③ View imported books and documents directly on AINOTE.


#### Method 2: Wi-Fi Import

- ①Go to the AINOTE Bookshelf interface and tap the Import button.
- $\ensuremath{\textcircled{2}}$  Enter the Wi–Fi Import interface and check the provided address (http://).
- ③ Connect both AINOTE and your PC or mobile device to the same Wi-Fi network.
- Open a browser on your PC or mobile device and enter the AINOTE-provided address (http://).
- (5) Access the transfer interface and select local files to import.
- ® View the imported books and documents directly on AINOTE.

#### Method 3: Cloud Drive Import


